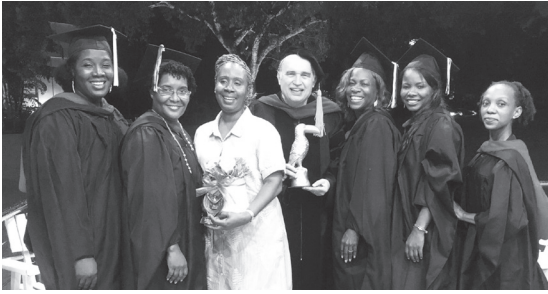


ABOUT
